































= Cultural notes =

Zenith is an exploration of thoughts on being mixed-race, and of classic folklore and historic sciences from the Muslim world and the Middle/Near Eastern, Arabian, and South Asian regions.

The word "zenith" comes from the Arabic "samt ar-ra's," meaing "path over the head."

Jackals have a large place in folklore from these spheres; a popular example of this is Kalila wa Dimna, also known as the Panchatantra, a famous compilation of stories-within-stories about two jackal brothers and their different approaches to society, morals, and relationships. (Certain parts of Kalila wa Dimna are sometimes subtitled as How To Lose Friends.)

A lot of Zenith was inspired by these stories, as well as others that feature jackals and wolves.

Much of our current understanding of eclipses is founded on the discoveries made by Al-Biruni, a great Muslim scholar of the past. The diagrams of the in-story eclipse in Zenith are based off his original hand-drawn diagrams. (The equations shown are modern-day math.)

The deity of the eclipse in Zenith is orbited by orbs with an Arabic letter on them; these letters correspond to the first letter of each word for The Six Pleasures of Medieval Islam -- drink, clothing, intercourse, scent, sound, and food -- with food being at the top, as it was considered the greatest of them all. Food is an important asset of history from the Muslim and Arabian world, and dishes that were eaten hundreds of years ago are still enjoyed relatively the same today.

Among those foods are dates, soups, jams, grape leaves, olives, bread, and others. (Grape leaves are a personal favorite of mine!!)

The deity of the eclipse is also riding on a dark storm cloud, which is often associated with the myth of the djinn.
